# MARINA RULES

*To be read in conjunction with Marina Terms & Conditions*

1. Only craft in seaworthy condition will be admitted to the Marina, or any part of the areas or waters within the Marina. Occupants of the Marina shall keep their craft in such condition that it does not become unsightly or dilapidated or reflect unfavourably upon the reputation & appearance of the Marina. Any craft found to be in contravention of this by-law will be requested to vacate the Marina
2. Craft within the Marina shall be insured, registered, equipped & maintained as required by law & safe practice, with particular attention to adequate fire-fighting equipment
3. When a craft enters the Marina, it shall immediately come under the jurisdiction of the Marina Manager & on occasion Marine Employees & shall be berthed & manoeuvred only when directed
4. Occupants of Marina berths shall provide & maintain their own mooring lines to standards & specifications approved by the Marina & Yard Manager. Port Geographe Marina reserves the right to renew, replace or make good any mooring lines at the Marina berth occupant's expense
5. Occupants of Marina berths shall ensure that no loose ropes float or obstruct in any way the adjacent berths
6. Craft in the Marina shall be moored in a manner that prevents any part of the craft or attachment thereto from projecting over the walkway. This requirement shall be met regardless of the wind direction
7. The Marina walkways shall be kept clear of all gear, including dinghies & trolleys. Trolleys shall be immediately returned to their proper place at the shore end of the Marina immediately after use. Equipment may be left temporarily on the mooring fingers of the Marina only by prior agreement between the occupants of that finger
8. Equipment & fittings may only be permanently affixed to the Marina structures after prior approval from the Marina Manager & in accordance with guidelines established by the Marina Management
9. Occupants of Marina berths shall forthwith remove from the Marina to waste bins provided at the side gate of the Marina nearest the public carpark, all waste & rubbish brought upon or generated within the craft or the Marina
10. Major repairs, painting & fitting of or to craft in the Marina is prohibited. Minor repairs, painting, mechanical adjustments & electrical work is permitted provided that no nuisance or interference with or danger to others using the Marina is caused by such work
11. Toilets, oil, chemical, spirits, inflammables & oily bilges shall not be discharged into the waters of the Marina
12. Fish must not be cleaned in the Marina
13. Laundry of any type or any items of a personal nature shall not be hung to dry out or air in public view aboard or from any craft in the Marina
14. Living aboard vessels in the Marina is NOT permitted without prior approval from the Port Geographe Marina Office Staff
15. Speed limits set for the Marina as displayed &/or advertised from time to time, shall be observed within, departing from or when approaching the Marina
16. Any collision or damage within or to any part of the Marina shall be reported to the Port Geographe Marina Office within 24 hours of the occurrence
17. A Pen Licensee who has an allocated Marina Berth & who sells or otherwise disposes of a vessel must remove the vessel within 30 days of such sale or disposal & inform the Marina Office immediately thereafter, unless the purchaser will be renting a Marina Berth
18. Boat owners wishing to use contractors to work on their boats whilst in the Marina shall use only contractors who have been authorised in accordance with Marina Management
19. Persons working on boats whilst in the Marina shall use only tools & equipment that are safe & fit for the purpose
20. Electrical equipment connected to shore power shall be of the type that is safe & fit for the purpose as per the "Port Geographe Marina Connection to Marina Power" document. Non-compliant electrical cords will be disconnected immediately
21. Visiting boats occupying designated Visitor Berths shall comply with the Terms & Conditions of the Marina

By signing the Pen Rental Agreement over the page, I, the licensee have read & understood the Marina Rules. I acknowledge that failure to comply may result in the Pen Rental Agreement being cancelled.
